The Community Crisis Response Unit (CCRU) provides “point of entry” mental health services to consumers. These services may include, but are not limited to, emergency crisis intervention, involuntary mental health evaluations, clinical assessment evaluations and 23-hour voluntary in-house crisis stabilization. The Community Crisis Response Unit (CCRU) also serves as the gatekeeper for access to in-patient psychiatric hospitalizations for Tehama County Medi-Cal recipients who may require acute psychiatric services. The Community Crisis Response Unit (CCRU) is “free-standing” and is staffed 24 hours per day 7 days per week by at least two mental health professionals per shift, one of which is a licensed nurse. Crisis interventions are performed in person or by telephone.
