## Guidance for Business Updated Guidance Documents

In an effort to keep businesses updated on new guidance coming out from California Department of Public Health (CDPH) Tehama County Health Officer, Dr. Richard Wickenheiser, has reviewed all the guidance released on Friday, June 5, 2020 and determined the following businesses in Tehama County may reopen effective today, June 8, 2020 as long as they follow the state's guidance. **On June 10, 2020 we became aware that movie theaters have been added to the Family Entertainment guidance. Dr. Wickenheiser has approved them to reopen effective June 10, 2020 as long as they can abide by the state guidance.**

We have also created a document, specific to Tehama County, that visually displays which businesses are currently able to open and which ones are not able to be open yet. This document is available on our [website](#) and will continually be updated as the state issues their guidance.

Our goal continues to be to help businesses in building their back-to-business plans. Tehama County Health Officer, Dr. Richard Wickenheiser and Tehama County Health Services Agency Public Health released [Guidance for Business](#) on 4/23/2020 on

building a reopen plan. Plans can be [submitted online](#) for review. Certificates for approved plans will be issued as the business is allowed to open to show your clients that you have had your plans reviewed and approved but having the certificate in hand is not required to reopen.

If your business is included in this list and you have already received approval for your plan; review the guidance to make sure you are meeting all the requirements and make any necessary modifications before reopening. Your certificates will be delivered, you do not need to wait for your certificate to reopen.

Plans that are approved by the Health Officer may not allow you to reopen your business until the Governor's Orders are lifted or modified but having a plan in place will position you to reopen safely as soon as possible. Tehama County was granted a variance allowing our jurisdiction to move more quickly through the reopening process than much of the state. It is important that we continue to follow this guidance.

We continue to encourage employers to promote face coverings; it is included in many of the industry guidance documents.
