<b>Informational Presentation: WIC Program with Ashley Fasking, RD</b>	Ashley Fasking, RD is a Registered Dietitian that supervises the Women, Infants & Children (WIC) program in Tehama County presented about how the WIC program has modified to continue to serve clients through the COVID-19 pandemic. Appointments and classes are virtual, benefits are automatically loaded to client's debit cards, and participation rates have increased.

<b>Public Health</b>	<p>The COVID-19 testing clinic continues to provide testing to the general public at the Red Bluff Community Center 3 days a week.</p> <p>The COVID-19 vaccination clinic continues to provide vaccines to the general public, over the age of 16. Appointments and walk-ins are available Tuesday-Friday. Parents/Legal Guardians must be present with 16 and 17 year olds. So far over 14,000 vaccines have been administered at this site. We are grateful to have the continued support of the National Guard to provide administrative and medical services.</p>	
<b>Empower Tehama</b>	<p>Michaele Brown announced that 4/28 is Wear Denim Day. This is an annual campaign to bring awareness for Sexual Assault Awareness Month. Empower Tehama plans to have a booth at the rodeo for the first time ever to provide information to the community about their services and programs. They also plan to attend Farmers Market.</p>	
<b>Greenville Rancheria</b>	<p>COVID-19 vaccines are available by appointment for Moderna and Pfizer. The annual health fair planned for 5/22 will be a drive-thru.</p>	
<b>NCCDI</b>	<p>There are no closures currently due to COVID; one site closed due to low enrollment. New registration is open.</p>

Working with Adventist Health Feather River to get a mobile dental clinic in Tehama County to improve access to oral health services.</p> <p>Amanda Wilson will be the school nurse providing health education classes to students in Juvenile Hall. Condom use has decreased. Working with St. Elizabeth Community Hospital and the WIC program to discuss teen pregnancy rates during 2020.</p>
