	<p>They also reported a decline in sexual activity in high school age youth but an increase in unprotected sexual activity.</p> <p>Jenny added that she went to teach puberty education to a 5th grade class yesterday and she was surprised that the students didn't even have knowledge of basic anatomy. They did not know that terms for male reproductive body parts are not interchangeable, it's not all the same body part. She had to teach basic anatomy terms and then teach the reproductive/puberty subject. The teacher said their standards changed 2 years ago and they no longer teach the basic body systems.</p>
